Dear WPA'ers:

The project #20 "Happening" will begin at the Best Western Icicle Inn at Leavenworth, Washington on June 4th. The Icicle Inn is on Highway 2 near Icicle Road. It is the first Inn that you see as you enter Leavenworth going East. The Inn is holding a block of rooms for us. The cost is \$70.00 plus 7.9% hotel tax, per night. Our "Attitude adjustment" will begin at 4:00 in the Icicle Inn's Boardroom. The Inn has a wonderful breakfast room with a complimentary European Breakfast, which includes fruit, fruit juices, cereals, toast, muffins or sweet rolls and beverages. If you aren't satisfied after all of that, the golf course serves breakfast as well as lunch. The plans for our dinner are not finalized yet. We will keep you informed...

The local golfers get the first starting times on Monday morning, so our first starting time is 10:30. All green fees and golf cart rental must be paid by one check so when you respond to this letter please enclose a check for your golf green fee and cart rental. Green fees are \$18.00 for 18 holes and \$12.00 for 9 holes. Cart rental is \$20.00 for 18 holes and \$10.00 for 9 holes. (Remember, the cart rental is for two.)

The non-golfers will have a wonderful time exploring Leavenworth. It is a shoppers paradise. The town is mostly on two streets each about 2½ blocks long. The choices for non-golfers for lunch are wonderful (we love the hamburgers at the micro-brewery at the west end of Front Street--look for the Onion-dome). But if you'd rather have a Bavarian experience there are many other choices. The best bakery in Leavenworth is 1½ miles down Icicle Road past the golf course. HomeFires Bakery is closed on Tuesday and Wednesday. Their old German Wood-fired oven bakes 50 loaves of bread at a time. They make the best oatmeal cookies and great pies. There are tables outside to enjoy a beverage and a treat. One oatmeal cookie will get you around the golf course. Beginning in June, there is "Art-in-the-Park" in downtown Leavenworth each week-end.

For now, MARK YOUR CALENDAR FOR JUNE 4 and 5th. Fill out the enclosed information sheet and mail it back to us with your check for green fees and cart rental. Call the Motel (509)548-7000 and confirm your room reservation with a credit card. *or use the enclosed card.*

We're looking forward to a happy time with you in sun-shiny Leavenworth on June 4th and 5th.

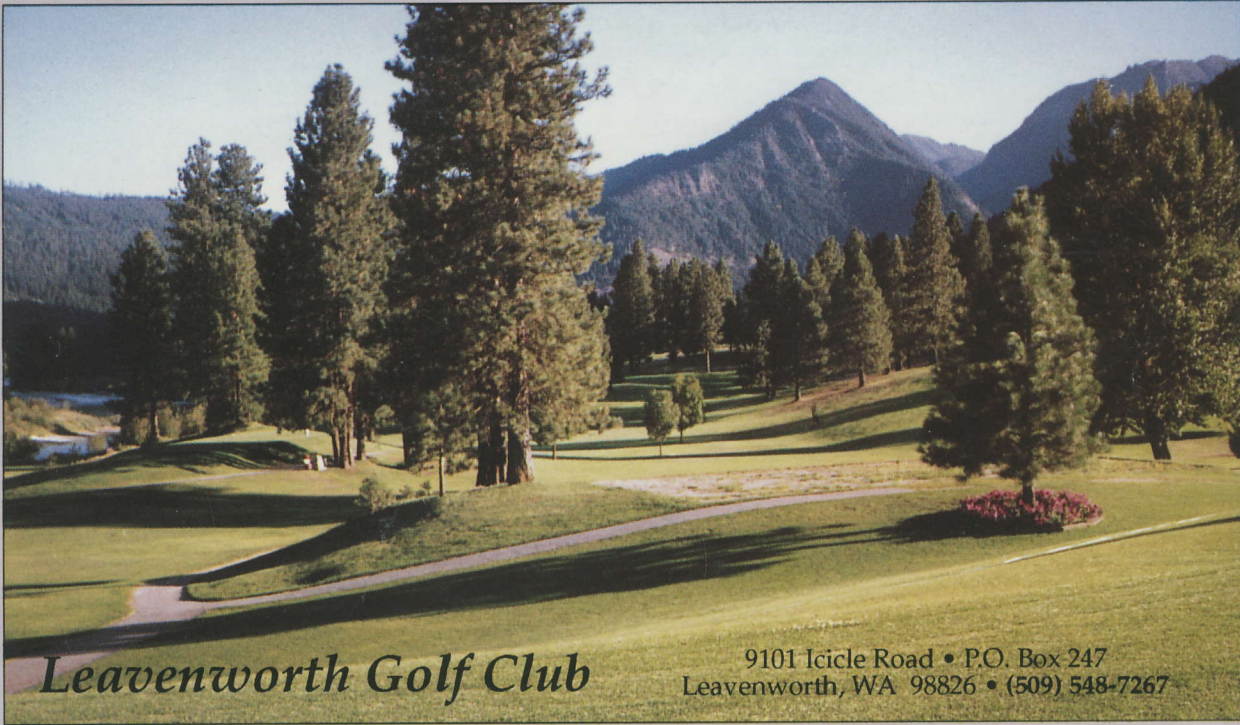

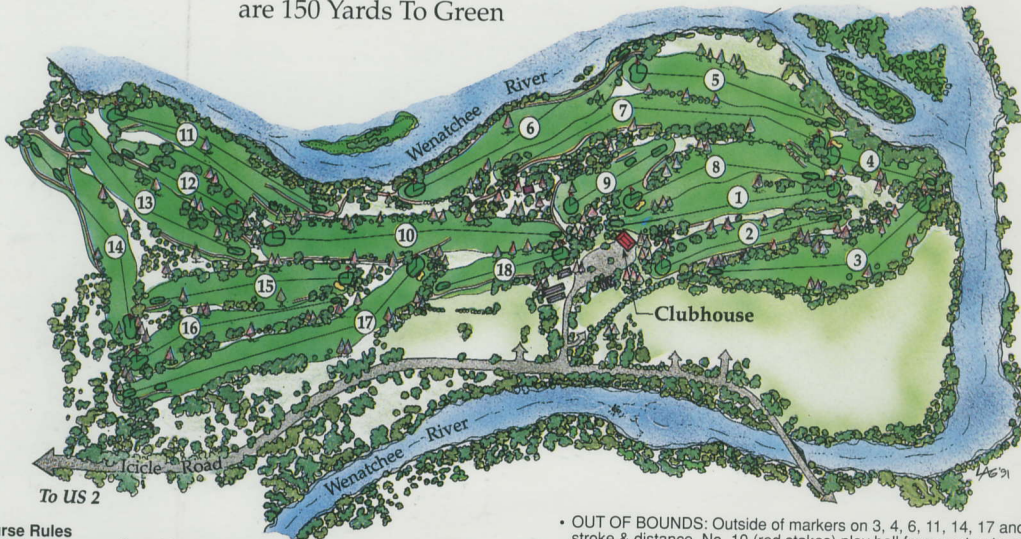

### Small Pine Trees are 150 Yards To Green



#### Course Rules

- U.S.G.A. Rules prevail, and local rules as may be posted.
- All areas outside white stakes & posts of boundary fences are out of bounds.
- Keep golf carts 40 feet from tees & greens.
- No children under 9 are allowed on course. No children under 12 allowed on weekends.
- 90° Golf Cart Rule - Wherever practicable, drive carts on path to a point opposite your ball, cross fairway at 90° and return to the cart path as soon as possible.
- 150-Yard Markers - (3' pine) - Shall be considered obstructions.

- OUT OF BOUNDS: Outside of markers on 3, 4, 6, 11, 14, 17 and 18. Penalty stroke & distance. No. 10 (red stakes) play ball from spot entered. Penalty 1 stroke.
- If flagged trees interfere with swing, drop ball 2 club lengths, no closer to hole.
- Cart Paths - Paved or gravel cart paths are obstructions. The player may lift and drop, without penalty, within one club length of nearest point of relief - not nearer the hole.
- Flower Beds - Shall be considered obstructions.
- The reservoir on 14 is a lateral hazard as defined by red stakes.

**THE COURSE MARSHAL WILL ENFORCE THESE RULES.**
