We are celebrating our 25th Project of the WPA started some twelve and one half years ago. Over the years the format of couples hosting the event at a variety of locations has proved successful. Jack Frisk suggested we form a committee and celebrate the event by inviting former members of the WPA to participate as they also were instrumental in making WPA a success. We encourage past and present members to attend-both golfers and non-golfers.

We have selected Yakima, Washington and the new Apple Tree Golf Course as our choice for those who wish to play golf. There are a variety of interesting places for both golfers and non-golfers in the area.

1. The city of Toppenish (20 miles south of Yakima), with thirty-eight "Murals" painted on buildings depicting the history of the town from 1850 to 1920, will provide a very interesting place to visit. We will arrange for a group tour if there's enough interest shown.
2. Yakima Valley Rail & Steam Museum in Toppenish for the railroad buffs.
3. Yakima Valley Museum in Yakima with exhibits and collections that tell stories of the area's natural history, the Yakima Indian Nation, fruit industry and horse drawn vehicles.
4. Yakima Valley winery's. Twenty three of them are located in the immediate area in the towns of Zillah, Granger, Sunnyside, Prosser and Grandview along highway I-82.
5. Yakima Nation Cultural Center The center includes a winter lodge/meeting hall, museum, theater, library and research center. The 76-foot high lodge is a stylized version of the ancient Yakima winter lodge.

Members may want to come a day early to take in all the interesting places to visit.

Location of Apple Tree Golf Course. 8804 Occidental Ave. Yakima, Wa.

Driving directions: Take Knob Hill Exit of Interstate 82 heading west through Yakima. Turn left on 64th Avenue and proceed through Washington Avenue intersection. Turn right on Occidental Avenue and go approximately 2 miles. Look for the Apple Tree entrance on your left.

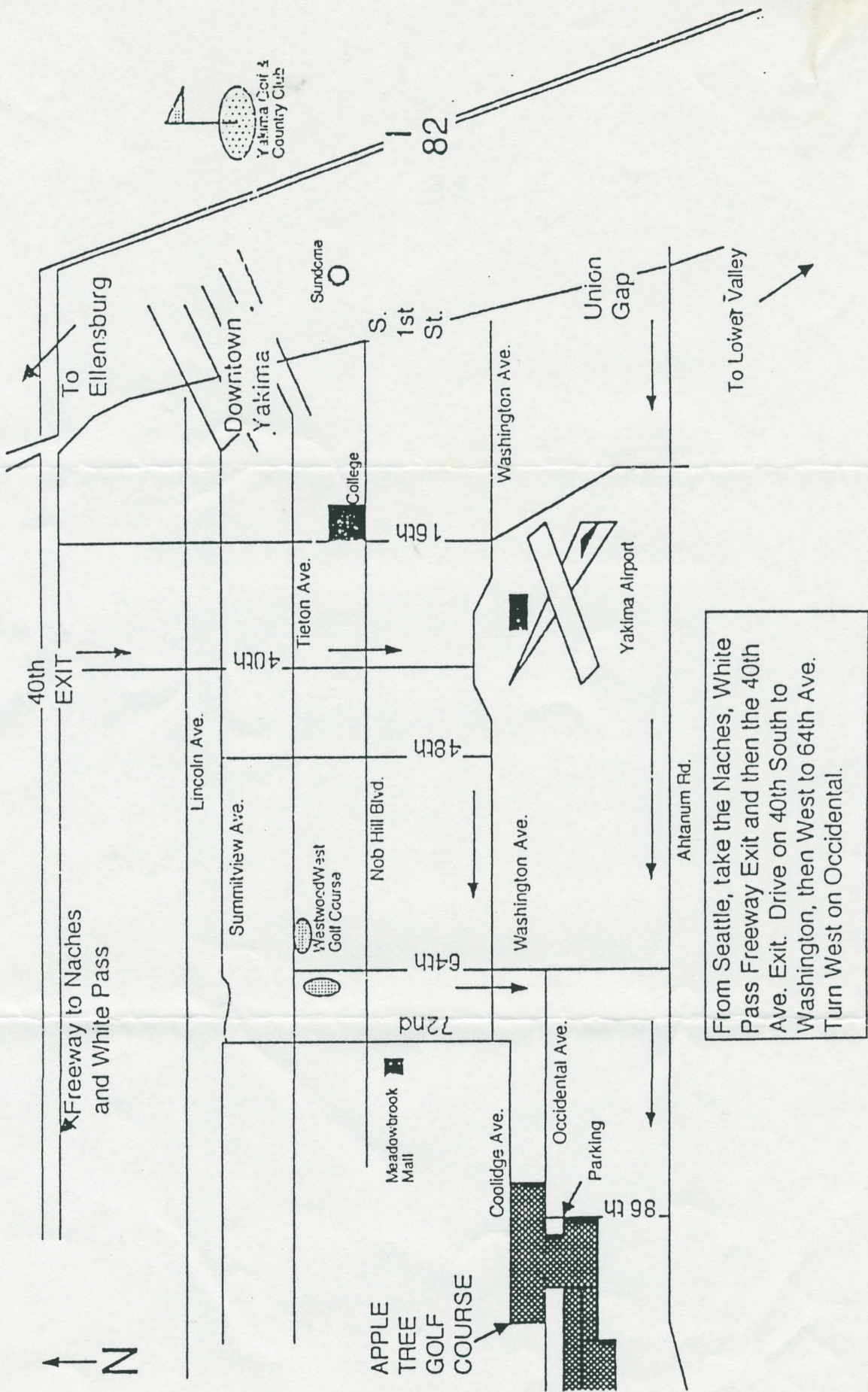
