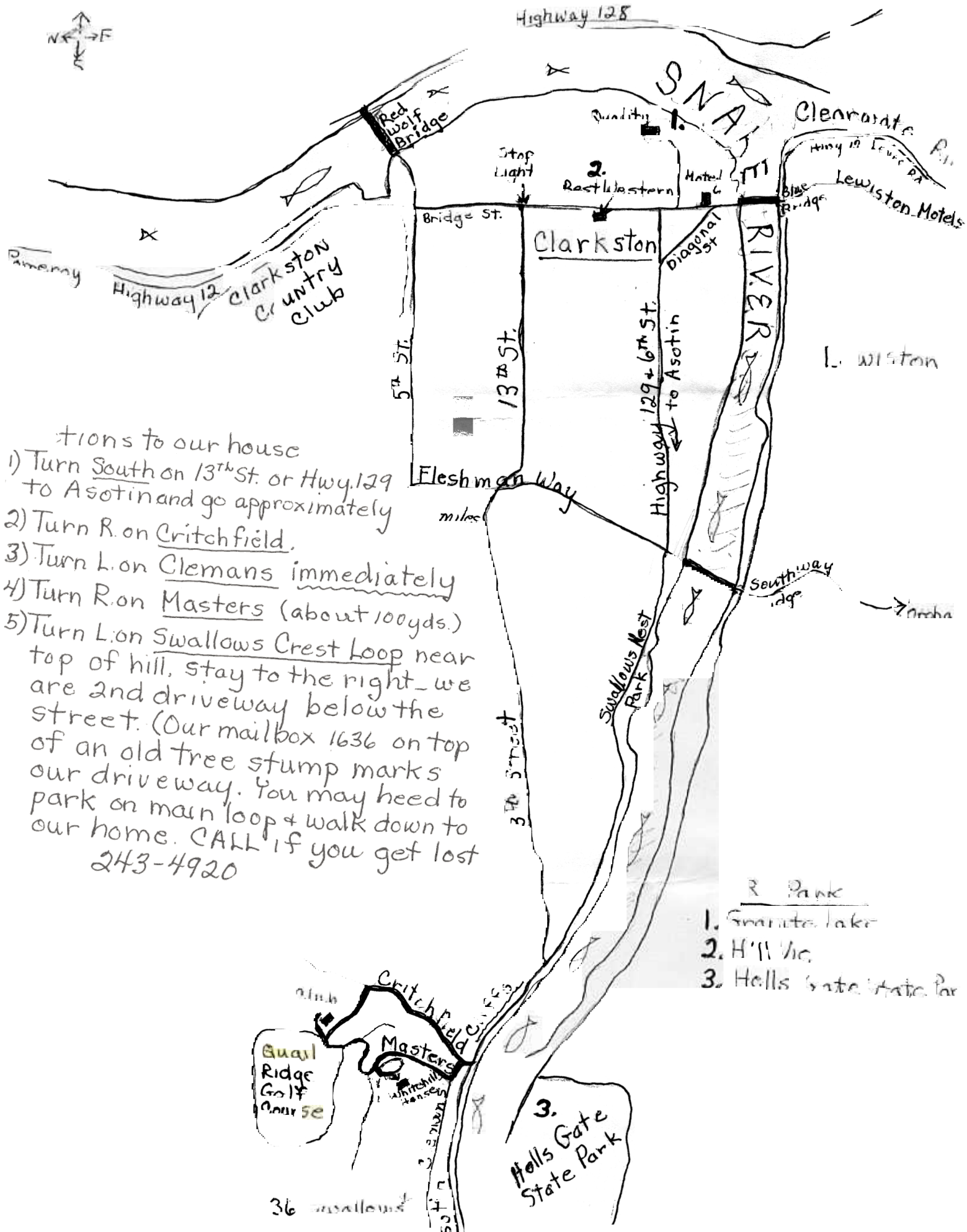
For those interested in playing Tuesday, we will have the format and other golf information ready at the Monday awards meeting.

 - 3) Turn L. on Clemans immediately
 - 4) Turn R. on Masters (about 100 yds.)
