Dear Jack,


We received the info from Bill on the WPA tournament. Sorry to say that we will not be making this trip. To many things all happening at the same time. Please pass the info on to Bill.

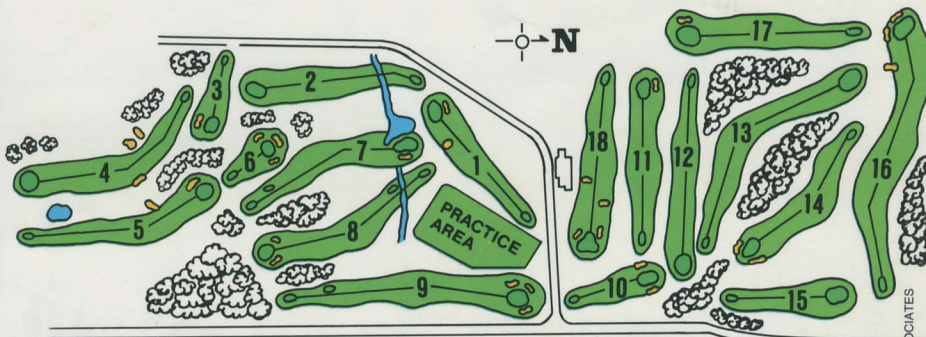
